- Monroe 2 BOCES
  - added 3<sup>rd</sup> teacher to welding/machining program
  - 54 new first year enrollees
  - Constant communication and Educating parents, teachers, and counselors had helped boost enrollment
- Monroe 1 BOCES
  - 22 new students
  - Perkins grant being utilized
- FLCC
  - Mechatronics program starting Monday with TCTI
  - 12 people enrolled
  - It's a non-credit class
  - 247 hours (12 weeks)
- LISK
  - 14 new students starting up!
- MCC
  - 54 Full-Time credited students
  - 16 Evening accelerated program students
  - STILL NEED TEACHERS!!!!
